

Community Health Nurse/Home and Community Care Nurse (CHN) .6 FTE

Inter Tribal Health Authority (ITHA) is a multi-disciplinary health organization providing services to 29 member First Nations on Vancouver Island based in Nanaimo, British Columbia. We are seeking a Community Health Nurse (CHN)/ Home and Community Care Nurse (HCCN) to provide support for Penelakut First Nation.

As a Community Health Nurse or Home and Community Care Nurse, you will report to the ITHA's Director of Nursing while managing mandated CDC programs. This includes family and individual client assessment; screening, evaluation and reporting (e.g. Immunizations, home nursing care, pre-and post-natal women, infants, children, individuals with chronic/long-term illnesses, diabetes management and the elderly); coordinating and delivering services such as acute care nursing, foot care, client assessments, case planning; collaborating with the client, family, physician and home care team to develop personal care plans; and assigning appropriate resources and referrals to meet client health & wellness needs.

Working within the context of the client-centered, holistic vision of ITHA and First Nation communities (in accordance with CRNBC Standards of Practice), this position requires the knowledge of health sciences combined with assessment and clinical nursing skills to effectively assess and coordinate client care. In this position you will provide professional health advice and information to individuals, families, and communities requiring health support and access to services. You will also be an advocate for bridging gaps between communities and external service agencies. This position requires strong administrative and organizational skills

This position requires an excellent working relationship and collaboration with the First Nation Health Authority (FNHA), Island Health, and the Aboriginal Health team. The ideal candidate has a Bachelor of Science or Nursing degree, current CPR/AED Level C Certification, current immunization certification and minimum two years' experience working as a Community Health Nurse and/or Home and Community Care Nurse (preferably in a rural/remote setting). Other requirements include cultural competency in First Nation's health, a valid class 5 driver's licence, and a willingness to travel if required.
